Learn about Seattle's historic waterfront from our expert guides and get an up-close look at one of the west coast's largest shipping terminals. Take in the view of the city's skyline with a spectacular panoramic background of the Cascade and Olympic mountain ranges, including majestic Mt. Rainier.

Our comfortable vessels offer both indoor and outdoor seating areas, restrooms, and full-service bars for beverage and snack purchases. All seating is first-come, first-serve and guests are encouraged to move about the vessel throughout the cruise.

Redemption Instructions

Vouchers must be redeemed in-person for a boarding pass. **Before joining the check-in line in the courtyard, visit the Argosy Cruises Reservations Center at Pier 55** where a member of our Shoreside Hospitality team will complete your reservation.

The Harbor Cruise departs from Pier 55 on the Seattle Waterfront at 1101 Alaskan Way, Seattle WA 98101. The Argosy Cruises Reservation Center & Gift Shop is located on the south side of the courtyard, in the red building under the blue Argosy Cruises awning. Once you have redeemed your voucher for a boarding pass, check-in will take place under the blue tent in the courtyard.

Check-in begins 30 minutes prior to departure. The boarding gate closes promptly 5 minutes prior to departure.

If you or a member of your party uses a wheelchair or scooter, please check-in with an Argosy team member prior to boarding. Our crew are trained to assist guests in navigating our docks and vessels, and we do our best to pre-board guests who need extra time descending the ramp when possible. It is also our policy that a trained employee accompanies each guest who uses a wheelchair during boarding.

Our docks and vessels do move around on the water, so we recommend you wear low or no heels when joining us. The outside decks tend to get a little breezy so a coat or light jacket is also recommended if you want to sit or stroll the outer decks. We sail rain or shine all year long!
